Stephanie Telfer gets the lowdown on hiring a wedding co-ordinator

s any of my friends will testify – whether t's nights out, birthday presents or holidays, I'm the one with the plan. I pride myself on being a good organiser (who said control freak?) but when it comes to organising the biggest day of my life, I think even I could become overwhelmed. It takes a little more effort and dedication than setting a few reminders in your iCal. But that's where the services of a fantastic wedding coordinator come in...

MONEY TALKS

You might think that wedding co-ordinators are reserved for people with bigger budgets, but you'd be wrong. "We often find that couples

working with smaller budgets are in greater need of a wedding planner," says Emma Douglas from Aberdeenbased Timeless White. "We've got extensive knowledge of cheaper alternatives and most of our packages come in at fixed prices, so your budget

> doesn't affect what you pay us for the support and help that we provide."

Janice Grimley-Evans, managing director at Blue Thistle Weddings, agrees and explains that a good wedding planner will tailor packages to

accommodate each couple's budget and wedding size. "Our prices are reasonable and a full planning package costs around £,750. Most couples are planning their wedding over at least one year, so that works out at just over £2 per day or less for

> an entirely personal service."

And it's useful to note that hiring a wedding planner may also help you make savings elsewhere. As well as brilliant recommendations

and shortcuts, they often have established deals with local wedding suppliers and will be able to pass on discounts and savings.

EXCLUSIVELY YOURS

Another common





misconception is that hiring a wedding planner means giving over complete control of your wedding. "We had no idea what to expect; how much would they be involved and what would they actually be able to do?" says Louise Campbell, who married James Killough on 15th February this year at Ballathie House Hotel, Perthshire with the help of Ianice from Blue Thistle Weddings. "Janice would give us suggestions and if we didn't like the idea of something we said so. It wasn't a problem at all and it didn't feel like someone else was planning our big day; she was just there to help us." Kimmie Brown is a director of Fife-based Litu Ltd with husband George. She advises couples seek out a coordinator that has a passion for the work and is a people person. "I don't think you need to be a particular type of person but you do need people skills and the ability to put yourself in the client's position at all times," says Kimmie. "It's one of those professions where you cross the client/professional line and learn about the couple, their

family relationships and any

potential pitfalls that could become apparent."

HELPING HANDS

A solution was exactly what Carolyn Sweeney-Wilson and Brian Wilson needed when they married on June 2012 at Dunblane Cathedral followed by a reception in Doubletree by Hilton Dunblane Hydro. They hired Janice from Blue Thistle Weddings after their original venue went out of business just three months before the wedding day. "I realised the enormity of planning a completely different type of wedding in such a short space of time," recalls Carolyn. "Our original venue had a small chapel, whereas our new venue had a larger ceremony space and I wanted to make it feel as intimate as possible. We just didn't have the time to research this properly and at that point I realised we really needed some help."

After a few meetings and email exchanges, Janice and Carolyn started working together to create her perfect day. "I was already halfway along with my plans but Janice was there with her contacts and experience

for me to bounce ideas off. Her attention to detail was fantastic and she put so much effort into making everything

As a career woman and owner of two businesses, Alice Deer started to find wedding planning was a little more time consuming than she expected, so enlisted the help of Emma from Timeless White to lighten the load.

"We had multiple meetings and communicated via email," says Alice, who married hubby James in July 2012 at St Palladius Church then Drumtochty Castle, Auchenblae near Laurencekirk. "We used Pinterest collaboratively to share ideas. Something that initially had been rather daunting became a fun process!"


SPOTLIGHT ON toastmasters

In the lead up a co-ordinator can...

- · Help finalise table plans and décor; the little details
- · Confirm final details with suppliers
- · Give you a checklist and itinerary of the day with timings

TOP TP Have a couple of meetings with your planner to make sure everything is on track and progressing as agreed.

Starting out a co-ordinator can...

- Do an initial venue search and budget plan
- · Help with finalising venue arrangements
- Recommend potential suppliers, source quotes and be the initial point of contact
- · Get to know you and the kind of day you'd like to create

TOP TP Don't be scared to email and call your co-ordinator often; the more they know about what you want, the better they can meet your needs!

On the day a co-ordinator can...

- · Arrive at the venue to make sure everything is in place
- Keep the day running smoothly
- Take care of everything so that you can relax and enjoy your day!

TOP TP As long as you've had good communication with your coordinator then the day should run perfectly.
