CROSS-CONNECTION AND CONSUMER'S RESPONSIBILITY CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into by and between LONE OAK UTILITY DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as DISTRICT and

(Owner) (Lessee), residing at

hereinafter referred to as Consumer.

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the payment by the Consumer of a **\$50** NON-Refundable Activation Fee and a **\$150** REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT, the District agrees to furnish water to the Consumer for residential or business purposes, and the Customer hereby agrees to purchase water from the District, subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

1. Complying with the following provisions of the District's Cross-Connections Policy, "that no person shall cause a crossconnection to be made or allow one to exist for any purpose whatsoever".

This policy defines a cross-connection as: Any physical connection whereby the public water supply is connected with any other water supply system, whether public or private, either inside or outside of any building or buildings, in such manner that a flow of water into the public water supply is possible either through the manipulation of valves or because of ineffective check or back pressure valves, or because of any other arrangement.

(1) (We) declare that no cross-connections, as prohibited by the District's Policy stated above, exists upon said premises as described above, and that (1 am) (we are) the (Owner) (Lessee) of said premises and do hereby agree not to permit any cross-connection upon said premises.

2. It is further understood that there are water lines and facilities between the meter and (my) (our) place of residence for which I / we are responsible. It is also understood that if a leak occurs, NO adjustment will be given. Customer has the option to acquire Servline Leak and Servline Line Insurance to cover home and service line leaks. Servline Does Not cover sprinkler leaks or running toilets. It is also understood that the District is not responsible for the maintenance of water lines beyond the meter. The District requires you to use COPPER OR TYPE A BLUE PEX for all service lines from the meter to the dwelling WHICH SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED WITHIN THREE (3) FEET OF ANY UNDERGROUND UTILITY. The District also urges you to install a pressure reducing valve with a pressure of NOT LESS THAN 300 PSI (pounds per square inch).

REQUEST TO DISCONNECT SERVICE

A request must be made in writing by completing the District's Disconnection Request Form which includes the following: name on the account, service address, cut-off date, forwarding address, and a daytime telephone number where you can be reached.

THE MAXIMUM ALLOWED BY LAW WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL RETURNED PAYMENTS

PAYMENTS ARE DUE BY THE 27TH OF EACH MONTH.
